1If a covered family member has substantiated a positive COVID-19 test result during the months of April, May or June of 2020, the insured will receive the additional benefits listed to the right.

COVID-19 and related conditions will be considered a pre-existing condition if your client tests positive for COVID-19 prior to the effective date of their policy. Pre-existing conditions will not be covered under the policy for the first twelve months of coverage (pre-existing periods vary by state).

WAIVED PREMIUMS¹

Following the positive test result the company will waive your next two monthly premiums on your Health Choice or Health Saver Series policy.

INCREASED PRESCRIPTION BENEFITS¹

The company will double the normal prescription benefit for any prescriptions filled during the months of April, May and June.

INCREASED INPATIENT BENEFITS¹

If you or your covered family member are subsequently admitted to a hospital during April, May, June or July of 2020 for a COVID-19 related illness, you will receive the following inpatient benefits:

- The Company will double the normal Facility Daily Indemnity Benefit for the first five days of inpatient stay (this includes the ICU and non-ICU inpatient Daily Indemnity Benefit only).
- For the next 25 days of the insured's inpatient stay the company will increase the normal Facility Daily Indemnity benefit by 50% (this includes the ICU and non-ICU inpatient Daily Indemnity Benefit only).
